Dear Church Family:

I want to share a very exciting update. Beginning September 1st, Cheyenne Kirkpatrick will be our Director of Christian Education (DCE). The session has hired her for this next school year, with the possibility that her time on staff may extend beyond that time frame. Cheyenne's responsibilities will focus on youth and children, but her role will also involve coordinating and overseeing matters related to adult Sunday School and Christian formation.

Cheyenne is a well-known face at FPC. She grew up in our church. She's been very active in all aspects of church life, including, but not limited to, youth, Tenebrae, and handbells. Furthermore, she comes to this role with an abundance of gifts that are well suited for this kind of ministry, and, as importantly, she comes with a heart and love for our church and for forming disciples of Jesus Christ.

As you know, we've been searching for an associate pastor. Some of you may be wondering how this hire impacts that search. The answer is it doesn't. The associate pastor nominating committee (APNC) is still responsible for identifying and nominating a candidate. Should the APNC nominate a candidate to the congregation before the end of Cheyenne's contracted time, the session and Cheyenne will work out a plan that is in the best interest of both. While Cheyenne is our (DCE), she will have general oversight of Grace Notes, while Missy Leppert and Jo Little remain co-directors.

Personally speaking, I am very excited to have Cheyenne on board. I've been encouraged by what I see as a fresh wind of vibrancy and forward momentum in our life together as a Christian community. Please keep Cheyenne in your prayers as she takes on a more involved role here at the church. If you see any opportunity to support her ministry, please jump right in!
