

# A Note from our Pastor

Are you ready for Daylight Savings Time again? Well, ready or not, it is coming on Sunday, March 9. Every year we make the switch from regular time to daylight savings time and I always complain. I hate giving up that hour that we got back last fall. I must admit that I do enjoy the longer daylight in the evenings but I hate waking up in the dark in the morning and not having daylight until long past what I had become used to. I am a morning person and wake up early whether I want to or not because my biological clock is set for 5 a.m. or so and I cannot change it regardless of what I do. So, when the time "springs forward" as it does in March, who knows whether I will also sleep an hour more or if my body will continue to wake me up in the darkness and urge me to get some coffee quickly. Coffee is the best thing about waking up. It is often the reason why I wake up more cheerful than those who are night owls.

Lent will be nearly a week old when we begin DST. Ash Wednesday is on March 5 this year and it is a tradition in the Christian tradition to receive ashes on one's forehead as a sign of repentance on that day. We begin Lent with that tradition to show that we are serious about our Lenten journey for this year. Lent lasts 40 days, not counting Sundays, and it is a time of reflection and renewal for our spirits as we become involved in the spiritual disciples of reading scripture, prayer, church attendance, and finding ways of ministry to others who may become part of our daily experience.

Giving up a certain food is something some consider during Lent but it is not mandatory. Some do it as a sign of penitence or devotion, as a way to test themselves even as Jesus was tested in the desert before he began his ministry. I used to give up desserts for the Lenten season but I eat them so rarely now that it is not much of a sacrifice. If you don't miss that thing you are giving up, then it really has no meaning. That is the reason to give up something. If giving it up challenges you some way during Lent, then that challenge will speak to you in some way. Incidentally, since Sundays are not part of Lent, you can eat that chocolate cake on Sundays and you did not mess up.

Midweek Manna Services have been a tradition here for several years so on Wednesdays, beginning March 12 and continuing through April 9, we will gather in the Chapel at 6 pm and have a short devotional service with the serving of Holy Communion, followed by a dinner in the church fellowship hall. All are invited to be a part of these weekly events as they help us to find the fellowship in our Christian community that we need to discover meaning as we journey through Lent together.

The days will grow longer as we experience Lent and work our way toward Easter Sunday, April 20 this year. We will find the joy of the resurrection in a new and meaningful way as we give of ourselves to God through our Lenten practices. Even if you have never taken part in Lent, this year may be the year to experiment and see what may happen in your life as you open yourself up to the Spirit at work in our lives.
